
In response to your letter of November 18, 2013, the Oswego County Sheriff's Office would indicate that the proposed project in the Town of Hastings is under this office's jurisdiction for law enforcement purposes. This agency would provide general law enforcement services to your business the same as it provides to other businesses (i.e. responding to complaints or emergencies). From the information you provided, it does not appear that the law enforcement issues would vary much from those encountered at other venues within the county.

I note that the county is home to the Oswego, Brewerton and Fulton Speedways. Traffic control and pedestrian safety are always a concern but if routine events are similar to other speedways and your company has planned for same, it would seem that these events would not pose a problem. To my knowledge, those businesses also employ security on premises and to assist with parking. However, you should know that, at present staffing, this agency cannot commit deputy sheriffs for traffic control on a weekly basis.

You should also be aware that the County of Oswego has a mass gatherings law and for any events that you reference in excess of 5,000 persons you will need event-specific law enforcement, fire and EMS plans. To the extent that this requires resources from this agency, the county may seek reimbursement of its expenses attributable to same. You may wish to consult with the Oswego County Health Department if you plan any events which would trigger the mass gatherings law or in the context of the DEIS.

I trust this is of some assistance.
